WHAT IS STAND DOWN?

The original Stand Down was designed for homeless Veterans and modeled after the "Stand Down" concept used during the Vietnam War to provide a safe retreat for units returning from combat operations. At secure base camp areas, troops were able to take care of personal hygiene, get clean uniforms, enjoy warm meals, receive medical and dental services, mail and receive letters, and enjoy the camaraderie of friends in a safe environment. A Stand Down afforded battle-weary soldiers the opportunity to renew their spirit, health, and overall sense of well-being. Achieving these objectives requires a wide range of support services and time. Our Stand Downs are successful because we bring services to one location, making them accessible by homeless veterans.
